**COURSE DESCRIPTION**

The aim of this course is to develop students' ability to understand the basics of grammar and to enhance their vocabulary. It is also aimed to build a fundamental knowledge of grammatical structures and rules, and to improve students' vocabulary through the use of different techniques such as affixation, word formation etc. Students in this course will have extensive practice of verb tenses, nouns, pronouns, modal verbs, prepositions, comparison, regular and irregular verbs and other essentials of grammar.

**COURSE GOALS:**

By the end of the course, students will be able to:

- produce effective and grammatically correct sentences;
- use articles, phrases and clauses correctly;
- use several kinds of verb tenses, modal verbs and word formations correctly and appropriately;
- use different verbal forms (gerunds, infinitives and participles);
- produce simple ,compound ,and complex sentences correctly.

**ATTENDANCE:**

Students having more than 25% absences from class lectures will be debarred from the final exam.

**ASSESSMENT:**

There will be two mid-term exams, each of which will be worth 25% of the course mark. At the end of the semester, the final exam will be worth 50% of the course mark. Moreover, quizzes and class tests will be conducted but they will not be counted towards the overall grade.
